



# O Pedredo

## Technical Data:

Elevation: 320 m

Soil: gravels & river stones (alluvial soil)

Exposure: North - south

Grapes: Godello

Trellising: Trellis

Harvest: 1st week of September

Wines produced: A Coroa 100% Godello



## Description:

This plot is located in Valencia do Sil, in the municipality of Vilamartín de Valdeorras. Its extension of 1.5 hectares is placed in the driest area, within the valley that makes up the Sil river. Its vines are characterized to withstand dry years excellently.

It is characterized by having an alluvial soil with a frank texture and a predominance of gravels and river stones.



In this plot we are talking about deep and very rich soils. In the warmer and drier summer years (more and more common) it provides grapes with good acidity and alcohol content, appreciating an extra effort in wet years in handling the crop (green pruning) in order to regulate production and leaf surface in order to obtain balanced and fruity wines.
